Hayes' and download the free app from Phenix Digital. When you use the app for first time it will prompt you to enter the classes your children are in, this way the app will alert you when news or events which relate to your child's class are uploaded to the website. If you are in Explorers or Nursery we ask that you click the 'Reception' class as all Early Years information will be sent through this class.
